

SVFB Aviation General Familiarisation WBT-Training (Gen.-Fam.)

What is the Aviation General Familiarisation Training WBT (Gen.-Fam.)?

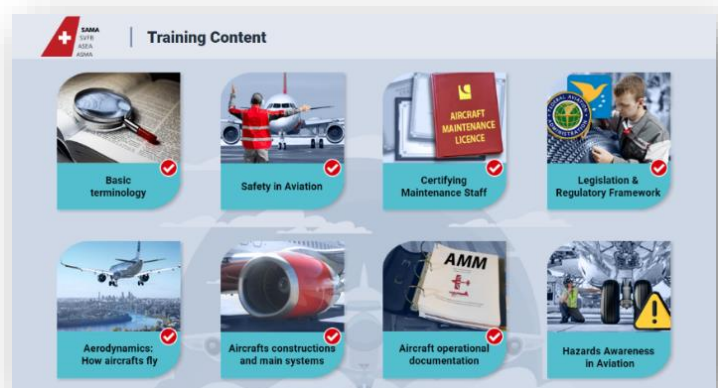
The Gen.-Fam. training is a web-based training (WBT) that has been specially developed for people who are new to the aviation industry or have moved into a position within aviation where a minimum technical understanding and basic knowledge of the applicable regulations is important. Young technicians - e.g. prospective aircraft mechanics and avionics technicians - can also benefit from this training.

Aim of the training

After this training, you will know the most common general terms that are important for the maintenance of aircraft, including maintenance certificates. You will be able to explain the most important safety and legal principles and recognise the most important hazards on and around the aircraft. You will be able to explain why and how an aircraft flies and which main systems it is equipped with.

How long does the training take?

As this is a WBT, you can work at your own pace and interrupt the training after each chapter to continue later. As a guide, you will need approx. 6 hours to complete the entire learning content including review questions.



Your access to the training is available for 6 weeks after activation.

In which language is the training available?

As the common language in aviation is English, this WBT is also in English.

Is there a certificate at the end?

Once you have completed the training, you will receive a personalised course certificate.

Do I need a computer, laptop or tablet?

Yes, you can't do it entirely without electronic equipment. But don't worry, the WBT works with all common systems.

What does the training cost?
